**DESCRIPTION OF ESSENTIAL DUTIES:** Under limited supervision, perform analysis, programming, testing, integration, enhancement, and modification of the agency's I.T. applications and databases; maintain the security, integrity, effective installation, integration, enhancement, operation and use of applications and databases in accordance with industry best practices; ensure that all data is fully normalized and in compliance with state directives and policies. Provide first level support for custom developed agency applications including providing support for ASP.NET, C#, HTML, CSS, JavaScript, and SharePoint based applications. As directed, maintain and administer agency IBM i servers and HMC including providing user configuration, backup and recovery, system operations, device configuration, PTF installation and general troubleshooting. Assist in evaluating, planning, designing, administering, and controlling I.T. projects and activities required for major regulatory and administrative information systems. As directed, serve as a liaison with governmental agencies, I.T. consultants and contractors to ensure technical specifications are met and proper interfacing of major systems and subsystems. Maintain detailed and comprehensive records of all work. Perform other related duties as assigned.

**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:**

**EDUCATION:** Bachelor's degree from an accredited college in business administration, computer science, computer engineering, systems engineering, software engineering, electronic engineering, electrical engineering or a closely allied field, including or supplemented by a minimum of 15 data processing/computer science credits.

Note: Completion of at least 240 hours of position-related technical training in a relevant area from an approved business school or training facility can substitute for the 15 data processing/computer science credits.

**EXPERIENCE:** Two (2) years of programming, systems analysis, or computer analysis experience. Application development experience in ASP.NET, C#, HTML, CSS, JavaScript, Visual Studio IDE, SQL server, and SharePoint is preferred. Experience in OS400, RPG, CL, and DB2/400 is desired.

Note: A master's degree in computer science, computer engineering, or closely allied field may be substituted for one (1) year of the required experience.

\* Salary Range: For current agency employees, salary upon reclassification will not exceed 10% above the employee's present base salary and may be below the posted minimum of the range.
