6	requests that NJSA 5:12-60b(1) generally
7	prohibits employment by a casino licensee or
8	applicant within a period of two years except
9	as may be permitted by statute, which 60b(2)
10	provides the exception to the two-year post-
11	employment restriction if the employee is
12	RIF'd, and if there's no appearance of a
13	conflict or actual conflict in fact.
14	We have reviewed Mr. Darville's
15	submission, and in light of the fact that his
16	position would be as a surveillance operator,
17	he had no prior contact during his employment
18	with Resorts at any level. We find and
19	recommend that there be a finding that he has
20	met the requirements and that you grant his
21	request.
