WHEREAS, the Commission considered the entire record of the proceedings at its public meeting of July 14, 2021.





RESOLUTION OF THE NEW JERSEY CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION CONCERNING THE JOINT PETITION OF MARINA DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, LLC AND MGM RESORTS INTERNATIONAL REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR TALIK MANDADI TO ASSUME THE DUTIES AND EXERCISE THE POWERS OF CHIEF STRATEGY, INNOVATION & TECHNOLOGY OFFICER OF MGM RESORTS INTERNATIONAL, PENDING PLENARY QUALIFICATION PURSUANT TO *N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.7(c)* and (d) (PRN 1872105)

RESOLUTION OF THE NEW JERSEY CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION CONCERNING THE PETITION OF AC OCEAN WALK LLC FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE TEMPORARY CASINO KEY EMPLOYEE LICENSE AND QUALIFICATION OF KELLY BURKE TO PERMIT HER TO PERFORM THE DUTIES AND EXERCISE THE POWERS OF CHIEF MARKETING OFFICER AND SENIOR VICE PRESIDENT OF AC OCEAN WALK LLC (PRN 1872107)

WHEREAS, casino licensee AC Ocean Walk LLC, d/b/a Ocean Casino Resort (“AC Ocean”) filed PRN2062006 dated July 24, 2020, seeking approval of the New Jersey Casino Control Commission (“Commission”) for the issuance of a temporary casino key employee license, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 5:12-89(e)* and *N.J.A.C. 19:41A-5.3(d)* to Kelly Burke, and for permission for Ms. Burke to serve as Chief Marketing Officer (“CMO”) and Senior Vice President (“SVP”) for Ocean for a nine-month period pending her plenary licensure and qualification, in accordance with the conditions contained in *N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1*, *N.J.S.A. 5:12-89* and *N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.6*; and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2020, the Commission, with the recommendation of the Division of Gaming Enforcement (“Division”), granted the Petitioner’s request and issued a temporary casino key employee license (#10315-11) and granted temporary qualification to Kelly Burke for a period not to exceed nine-months in accordance with the conditions contained in *N.J.S.A.*



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5:12-85.1 and *N.J.A.C.* 13:69C-2.6 (Commission Resolution No. 20-08-12-11);
and

WHEREAS, such temporary casino key employee license and temporary qualification was effective for a period of two (2) months and nine (9) days until October 21, 2020, at which time Ms. Burke no longer served in the position of CMO and SVP, thus her temporary casino key employee license lapsed, and she ceased to be a qualifier of AC Ocean; and

WHEREAS, Petitioner filed PRN 1872107 dated July 2, 2021 seeking a ruling from the Commission that it established good cause pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 13:69C-2.6 to extend the temporary casino key employee licensure and qualification of Ms. Burke to allow her to resume the duties and exercise the powers of CMO and SVP for AC Ocean, prior to her plenary licensure and qualification, until such time as she is issued an initial casino key employee license and is found plenary qualified; and

WHEREAS, the Division filed a response dated July 13, 2021, recommending that the Commission continue the temporary casino key employee license and temporary qualification of Ms. Burke for (6) months and twenty-two (22) days which is the remaining time period for the temporary casino key employee license and temporary qualification issued on August 12, 2020;

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
WHEREAS, the Commission considered the entire record of the proceedings at its public meeting of July 14, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commission that good cause has been established to continue the temporary casino key employee licensure and qualification of Kelly Burke; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the temporary casino key employee license of Kelly Burke is hereby continued effective July 24, 2021 and extended for a period of no more than six (6) months and twenty-two (22) days to February 15, 2022; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Kelly Burke is hereby temporarily qualified and authorized to perform the duties and exercise the powers of CMO and SVP for AC Ocean, effective July 24, 2021, for a period of no more than six (6) months and twenty-two (22) days, pending her plenary qualification, as permitted by *N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.6*, and subject to the conditions in *N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1* and *N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.6*.

WHEREAS, the Commission considered the entire record of the proceedings at its public meeting of July 14, 2021.






