IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the granting of Applicant's initial application for casino key employee license #10686-11 is specifically conditioned on Applicant complying with her voluntary agreement to make any payments required by the IRS, and is further conditioned on Applicant providing proof to the Division of her payments on an annual basis, beginning October 15, 2023, by sending a copy of all appropriate documentation to:
